

## And our Ciders

### Turners Ciders from Kent

**Apple Pie (5%)** Flavoured with spices and sweetened with fresh apple juice.

**Dry (7%)** Still, light, crisp cider with high acidity and low sweetness. Unfiltered and unpasteurised. \*Very Highly Commended at the British Cider Championships, Royal Bath & West Show, 2015\*

**Elderflower (5.5%)** Still, fruity and floral, naturally sweetened with elderflower syrup. Unfiltered.

**Medium (5%)** Still, cloudy, naturally sweetened with fresh-pressed apple juice, giving a full, fruit flavour. Unfiltered.

**Rhubarb (5%)** Does what it says on the box a blend of crisp cider and pressed rhubarb not too tart, not too sweet!

**Single variety Russet (8%)** Still, wine-like and easy-drinking. Medium-sweet, unfiltered. (5.5%)



### Glasses

We charge a deposit on glasses to save us constantly having to collect abandoned ones. You can take your glass home with you or get your deposit back, it is up to you.

If you would like us to freshen up your glass, just ask at the bar (the one with the handpumps on). When it is time to go home, if you want to exchange your glass for a fresh one to take home, just ask at the bar.

# Beer and Cider tasting notes

## Green hop beers shown in green

### On the Main (Club) bar

**Binghams - Vanilla Stout (Twyford 5.0%)** Infused with vanilla pods which complement the dark malts to create a smooth drinking, deliciously dark stout. Champion Beer of Britain 2016.

**Church End - Goat's Milk (Nuneaton 3.8%)** Golden yellow nectar. Pale barley, crystal malt and oats, blend to fill the palate with flavour. Aromatic hops dance over the tongue for a gentle hop finish. Champion Beer of Britain, 2017.

**Westerham - Scotney Green (Westerham 4.5%)** This best bitter is hopped with undried green hops from the National Trust's hop garden at Scotney Castle. A mild tasting, mid gold best bitter.

**Westerham - Gold Rush (Westerham 4.5%)** Gold Rush is brewed with 4 malts to create a complex malt backbone for the 6 American hops that drive a robust but balanced hop forward amber ale. Rarely found in cask.

### On the Festival bar

**3 Sods - Trade Union Pale (Bethnal Green 4.5%)** A light and fruity session ale using pale malts, chinook, cascade and admiral hops. Smooth citrus dry taste ending with a pleasant bitterness.

**Bexley - Hulkins Challenger (Erith 4.3%)** Challenger hops from the Hulkins farm in Tenterden make this beer a classic Kent bitter.

**Brew Buddies - Green Mild (Swanley 3.8%)** A classic take on an English mild loaded with 20kg of freshly picked East Kent Goldings. Soft fruity character.

**Brew Buddies - Green Buddy (Swanley 3.8%)** Loaded with 50kg of freshly picked East Kent Goldings this pale ale exhibits sweet and smooth flavours with a hint of honey and spice.

**Cronx - Palace Pint (Croydon 4.0%)** A classic English bitter brewed with hops grown by the residents of Crystal Palace.

**Cronx - Das Cronx (Croydon 4.8%)** A malty Oktoberfest style ale using Munich and Vienna malt

**East Kent - Collaboration (East Kent 5.0%)** This brew is a very special collaboration between Gadds' Brewery, Goody's Brewery, Wantsum Brewery, Canterbury Ales and Canterbury Brewers & Distillers. We all get our hops from our local Farmer and then meet up at Gadds' Brewery to brew this Kent Green Hop pale ale.

**East London - Walthamstow (Leyton 4.0%)** Zesty pale ale produced with Prima Donna hops grown in the gardens of Walthamstow.

**East London - Walthamstow (Dark) (Leyton 4.0%)** The hop harvest was so good that the brewery also produced an amber ale produced with Prima Donna hops grown in the gardens of Walthamstow.

**Gadds - Green Hop Pale (Ramsgate 4.8%)** A melange of East Kent hops, exact varieties dependent on the day. Pale, crisp, zesty and bitter.

**Goody's - Genesis Green Hop (Herne Bay 3.5%)** A dark ruby coloured ale with an extra fresh, lasting hoppy finish coming from green hops grown at the brewery.

**Goody's - Goodness Gracious Me (Herne Bay 4.8%)** India Pale Ale. Robust and citrus flavoured

**Kent - Green Giant (Birling 6.0%)** A colossal amount of freshly harvested East Kent Goldings creating a rare and complex Green Hopped IPA. A giant in every sense of the word.

**Musket - Flash in the Pan (Maidstone 4.0%)** A Golden Ale with infused aromas of floral, honey, spice and blackcurrant, with a pleasantly dry, lingering, after taste.

**Pig & Porter - Purest Green (Tunbridge Wells 5.2%)** Straw Pale and bursting with flavour from freshly picked East Kent Goldings giving a hint of zesty marmalade.
