

## Turners Ciders from Kent

**Dry (7%)** Still, light, crisp cider with high acidity and low sweetness. Unfiltered and unpasteurised. \*Very Highly Commended at the British Cider Championships, Royal Bath & West Show, 2015\*

**Elderflower (5.5%)** Still, fruity and floral, naturally sweetened with elderflower syrup. Unfiltered.

**Single variety Russet (8%)** Still, big and full flavoured. Medium-dry.

**Medium (5%)** Still, cloudy, naturally sweetened with fresh-pressed apple juice, giving a full, fruit flavour. Unfiltered.

**Apple Pie (4%)** Flavoured with spices and sweetened with fresh apple juice.

**Rhubarb (4%)** Blended with fresh-pressed Kentish rhubarb this is a very refreshing cider

**Easter Hill (6.9%)** Single variety Cox cider

**Gigglejuice (7.4%)** Russet and Bramley blend

**Scatterbrain (7.2%)** Cox, Russet and Bramley blend

**Bays (Devon) Topsail (4.1%)** A well balanced beer, deep amber in colour with a subtle sweetness.

**Beartown (Cheshire) Bluebeary (4%)** A beautifully balanced background of malt and subtle fruity hops to compliment the flavour and aroma of the blueberries infused into this highly sessionable golden beer.

**Beerblefish (London) 1820 Porter (6.6%)** Full of chocolate and coffee notes, based on a 1800's recipe, we avoid using roasted malts for this porter instead loading in the chocolate malt and wheat, giving the beer a smooth rich flavour.

**Brightside (Lancashire) New School (4.5%)** A boldly hopped golden ale, full of fresh and vibrant hop aromatics and flavours.

**Colchester (Essex) No 1 (4%)** A classic English best bitter, copper in colour. Whole leaf Boadicea hops for flavour and the definitive aroma of East Kent Goldings.

**Empire (Yorkshire) Rum Porter (4.7%)** Dark & rich but with a dry finish.

**Gadds (Kent) Dr Sunshine's Special Friendly (4.2%)** Zesty Kentish wheat beer.

**Great Newsome (Yorkshire) Ploughmans Pride (4.2%)** Easy drinking, moderately bittered deep chestnut ale.

**Iron Pier (Kent) Joined at the Hop (3.8%)** A session pale made with Cardinal and Ernest hops. A subtle tropical aroma with a punchy pineapple and citrus first taste.

**Marble (Manchester) Pint (3.9%)** A dry session bitter with a light malt base carrying a wonderful display of New Zealand hops.

**Musket (Kent) Matchlock Mild (3.9%)** A blend of four malts, roasted barley and Kentish hops, has produced this exceptional mild.

**Mutineers (Bromley) Soracchi Kidd (4.9%)** A single hop ale with sweet taste.

**Pennine (Lancashire) Heartland (3.9%)** Dark copper coloured ale with a toffee, malted caramel smell and a rich smooth moreish flavour.

**Skye (Scotland) Blaven (5%)** Rich malty character and well balanced hops combine to produce a lovely special bitter.

**Tonbridge (Kent) Velvet Raven (5.2%)** Lovely stout, full of fruit, with coffee and oatmeal in the background.

**Wantsum (Kent) Red Smacker (4.3%)** Red APA using special malts with a hint of caramel.

**Westerham (Kent) Viceroy (5.0%)** A true English IPA. The hops are Target and Progress grown from the National Trust's Scotney Castle hop garden.

**XT (Buckinghamshire) Lion London Porter (4.6%)** A rich, dark character matched with a toasty aroma and a hint of sweet earthy notes.

## Craft Keg

**Iron Pier Export Brown Stout (6.3%)** Export Brown Stout aged in Burgundy Barrels. The burgundy barrels lend a complex acidity and a subtle red berry character which adds a refreshing element to the beer.

**Westerham Wally Winkers (4.5%)** A decadent triple-chocolate stout with an intensely sweet, chocolaty nose. This is balanced by a medium-dry flavour of bitter chocolate rounded out by hints of sweet vanilla.
